

Information, Eligibility and Criteria for Honorary Life Membership Nominations

HONORARY LIFE

Honorary Life Membership is awarded in recognition of an extraordinary level of service to ANZIIF over an extended period of time on a national or international level. Two Honorary Life Memberships may be awarded each year.

Please note self nominations will be accepted.

NOMINATION OF HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP PROCESS

- Nominations should be made via email by 5:00pm AEDT on Friday 31 January 2025 and sent to Jasmina Nagar at agm@anziif.com.
- Nominations should include details about the nominee's background, ANZIIF and industry contribution and reason/s for nomination. Submissions should be no more than 500 words (approximately two A4 pages).
- · Nominations will be submitted to the ANZIIF Board for endorsement.
- · If successful, nominators will be advised of the outcome of their nomination application.
- Successful nominees will be contacted by ANZIIF and advised that they have been nominated for Honorary Life Membership.
 The nominations will be included as an ordinary resolution at the Annual General Meeting.
- Honorary Life Membership nominees will be invited to attend the Annual General Meeting to be held on Wednesday 14 May 2025.
- Successful nominees will receive a commemorative plaque and certificate at the Annual General Meeting, together with complimentary Life Membership at their current level of membership.

HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

To be eligible for nomination for Honorary Life Membership, nominees must:

- be a current member of ANZIIF
- have made an extraordinary level of commitment to ANZIIF over an extended period of time at a national or international level, beyond ANZIIF's normal expectations of its members
- not be a current ANZIIF Board, Advisory Board, Council or Committee member at the time of their nomination unless in exceptional circumstances.
- have ceased their service on an ANZIIF Board, Advisory Board, Council or Committee at least 12 months prior to the nomination, unless exceptional circumstances apply.

Please also note that:

- nominations for Honorary Life Membership may not be made posthumously
- the ANZIIF Board reserves the right to not award Honorary Life Membership/s in any given year.
