

Certificate IV in General Insurance

This document is applicable for students who commenced studies between 2016 to October 2021.

Every five years, a major review of the competency framework for the Financial Services Training Package is undertaken by an independent Industry and Skills Committee. This is part of a continuous improvement process to keep up to date with the industry's needs and changing circumstances. ANZIIF, like many other education providers, actively participated in identifying skills and knowledge needs in the workforce.

The 2020 Financial Services Training Package came into effect on 3 November 2021 for the FNS41420 Certificate IV in General Insurance. Continuing and new students need to **complete three (3) compulsory units and nine (9) elective units**. This table outlines the units and if applicable, the credit pathways from previous ANZIIF studies.
