The Peter Corrigan Scholarship for innovation and leadership aims to recognise and foster the professional development of young insurance professionals.

THE PRIZE

AUD\$10,000 will be awarded to the recipient to attend an international conference or seminar that provides a recognised industry or leadership-based professional development opportunity.

YOUR TOPIC

Describe an achievement or initiative you have executed at work that demonstrates leadership. An example might include:

- Leading a team through a crisis,
- An idea that contributed to revenue, cost savings or culture at the workplace, or
- Leading process improvement for better work practices.

HOW TO ENTER

Tell us what you did and how you did it in your choice of either:

- **A written submission up to 1000 words, or**
 - Essays must not exceed 1000 words (excluding any foot/endnotes, block quotations and the bibliography)
 - Microsoft Word format only. The file must be named as follows: initial of first name_surname.doc (eg: g_clarke.doc)
- **Short video (up to 5 mins), or**
 - Must not exceed 5 minutes and 50MB
 - Mp4 format. The file must be named as follows: initial of first name_surname.mp4 (eg: g_clarke.mp4)
- **A voiceover of images in PowerPoint**
 - Must not exceed 5 minutes and 50MB
 - Microsoft Word format only. The file must be named as follows: initial of first name_surname.ppt (eg: g_clarke.ppt).



WHO CAN ENTER

The Peter Corrigan Scholarship for innovation and leadership is open to insurance professionals who:

- Are current financial members of ANZIIF
- Are permanent residents of a country in the Asia-Pacific
- Currently work in the insurance industry.

JUDGING

Submissions will be assessed by a distinguished Judging Panel who will select the winning applicant of the Scholarship. The 2019 recipient will be announced at the ANZIIF Insurtech Conference at Sofitel Sydney Wentworth on 26-27 February 2019.

Your entry will be judged on

- Communication of the initiative
- Demonstration of the outcome/s
- Ability to initiate thought leadership.

APPLICANT DECLARATION:

I wish to be considered for the 2019 Peter Corrigan Scholarship. I declare that the application is correct, complete and meet the eligibility criteria. I declare and understand that:

1. I am a permanent resident of, and reside in one of the following countries - Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Myanmar, Cambodia, Canada, China, Cook Islands, Fiji, French Polynesia, India, Indonesia, Japan, Kiribati, Laos, Malaysia, Maldives, Marshall Islands, Micronesia, Mongolia, Nauru, Nepal, New Zealand, New Caledonia, Niue, Pakistan, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Peru, Philippines, Samoa, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Timore-Leste, Tonga, Tuvalu, Vanuatu, Vietnam.
2. The prize is non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.
3. I am a current financial member of ANZIIF and will receive six (6) CIP points for my application.
4. Submissions will be assessed by a distinguished Judging Panel. This panel will select the recipient of the Scholarship, and its decision will be final.
5. Finity and ANZIIF may make enquiries to ensure that the work presented is my own work.
6. Should my application be successful, I give permission to the Judging Panel to publicise my name, photo, position and company name as well as details of the international industry or leadership development opportunity selected.

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS

Final professional development proposal

Upon notification of success, the recipient of the Scholarship is required to submit to Finity Consulting for approval a final proposal with details of the actual industry or leadership-based international conference or seminar program that they would like to attend. It is envisaged that the selected program will take place in 2019, but development opportunities occurring in 2020 will also be considered.

In addition to providing details of the selected event, the proposal must explain how this event will aid the recipient's career objectives and development as well as benefit the insurance industry. It must address specific key criteria, which will be forwarded to the recipient.

Finally, the proposal must include an estimated budget that outlines the cost of attendance at the selected event. The recipient should keep in mind that the prize money of up to AUD\$10,000 is allocated to cover appropriate event attendance and registration fees, return economy airfares and accommodation costs for one person.
